Report on the Number of persons with Intellectual Disabilities Institutionalized on PEI



PEI Citizens Advocacy and Association for Community Living (ACL) got together to find out how many Islanders with intellectual disabilities are living in institutions on Prince Edward Island.

We went to large institutions, community care facilities, manors and private nursing homes across Prince Edward Island.

We found there are:

- 24 people in the Manor 13 are not seniors
- 56 people in Community Care Facilities and 42 are not seniors
- 9 people in Private Nursing Homes and 5 are not seniors
- 13 in Sherwood Home
- 24 + in Hillsborough Hospital.

That means there are **126** Islanders with intellectual disabilities are living in institutions across Prince Edward Island.
